Matthew Henry, Matthew Henry was a Nonconformist minister and author, who was born in Wales but spent much of his life in England. He is best known for the six-volume biblical commentary Exposition of the Old and New Testaments. Out of all the commentary and inspired books I use, Matthew Henry is the one I usually go to first. He breaks down his thought process aiding in a better understanding of his conclusions. He is very articulate which gives you a path to follow as he opens up the Scripture.

Jonathan Edwards, an American revivalist preacher, philosopher, and Congregationalist Protestant theologian. Edwards is widely regarded as one of America's most important and original philosophical theologians.

E M Bounds, American author, attorney, and member of the Methodist Episcopal Church South clergy. He is known for writing 11 books, nine of which focused on the subject of prayer. Only two of Bounds' books were published before he died.

Albert Barnes, American theologian, born in Rome, New York. He graduated from Hamilton College, Clinton, New York, in 1820, and from Princeton Theological Seminary in 1823.

Steven J. Lawson is president of [OnePassion](#) Ministries, a ministry designed to bring about biblical reformation in the church today, as well as the Professor of Preaching in the masters and doctoral programs at The Master's Seminary, Sun Valley, California.
